Product description	<p>Not all vermiculite contains asbestos. Only scientific testing will determine if the vermiculite contains asbestos.</p> <p>Vermiculite is a silver-gold to gray-brown mineral that is flat and shiny in its natural state. When heated to around 1000 degrees C, it puffs (or puffs up) which creates pockets of air. This expanded form, and the fact that vermiculite does not burn, made the material suitable for use as insulation and ceilings.</p> <p>Vermiculite itself has not been shown to be a health problem. However, some vermiculite insulation contained asbestos fibres due to contamination at the Libby Montana mine.</p>
